The NFA Executive Board would ask that you review the following options and be prepared for a formal vote. Voting will take place at our Annual General Assembly Meeting on Friday, July 23, 2010. This meeting will be held at the Marriott Waterfront Hotel, 700 Alicanna Street, Baltimore, MD and will start promptly at 9:00am ET. The merger discussions will take place in the afternoon, along with your NFA Board, representatives from Allied Finance Adjuster Conference, Inc. and American Recovery Associations, Inc. have been invited to address the membership and answer any questions you may have. After the discussions we will take a vote where each member will choose one of the options listed below:

#### VOTING CHOICES

- A. Authorization for the board members of National Finance Adjusters, Inc. to work out a three way merge between National Finance Adjusters, Inc., Allied Finance Adjusters Conference, Inc. and American Recovery Association, Inc.
- B. Authorization for the board members of National Finance Adjusters, Inc. to work out a two way merge between National Finance Adjusters, Inc. & Allied Finance Adjuster Conference, Inc.
- C. Authorization for the board members of National Finance Adjusters, Inc. to work out a two way merge between National Finance Adjusters, Inc. & American Recovery Association, Inc.
- D. Authorize the board members of National Finance Adjusters, Inc. to stop all discussions of a merger with any association. No merge.
